



Program Description

TeleScript JR is an entirely software-based teleprompting program. It is designed to be extremely quick to learn and easy to use, yet deliver professional quality results that have come to be expected from Telescript software. The program features simple script file management, a full range of text editing commands, and Telescript's super-smooth DirectScroll prompting engine -- the same engine featured in Telescript's most advanced products.

Minimum System Requirements*

For Windows 2000 or Windows XP:

- 233-Mhz Pentium II processor
- 128 Megabytes of RAM
- 10 Megabytes of available disk space
- VGA-compatible display adapter and monitor

** These are absolute minimum requirements provided by Microsoft for running these operating systems. Performance is generally improved with faster processors, more memory, faster video cards with more video memory, etc.*

Installation

The TeleScript JR installation is a self-extracting EXE file. Start the installation process by double-clicking it -- installation will start immediately.

The default settings are fine for most users - you're safe to just click the 'Next' button until the installation is complete.

After the installation is finished, you will see an icon called 'TeleScript JR' on your desktop, and a Start Menu program group called 'TeleScript'.

Note to Windows 2000 / XP Users:

You need to have Administrative privileges to install the software. Please see Windows Help for more information on user privileges.

Starting Up

You can start the TeleScript JR program by double-clicking its icon on the desktop, or by selecting its icon from the Start Menu folder.

When the program opens, a dialog box will appear asking you to enter your unlocking password.

Registration & Demo Mode

If you are just evaluating the software without having purchased a license, click on the 'Demo' button to use the program in its restricted mode.

If you have obtained an unlocking code from Telescript for your computer's installation, copy and paste it or enter it exactly, including the dash, into the box, then click 'Register'.

If you need to obtain an unlocking password for your computer, please contact your Telescript representative with the "Computer ID" code that's listed in the registration dialog box. They will then send you your unique unlocking code for your computer.

IMPORTANT NOTE: A TeleScript JR unlocking code will only work on the computer that was registered. Please contact Telescript if you need to install the software on more than one computer.

Program Navigation

Once the program is started, the prompting window will cover the entire screen. You will notice a triangular arrow on the left -- this is the prompter eye line indicator. The rest of the area to the right is the script area, where the text will be displayed.

All program functions are accessible through a Context Menu. This menu is displayed by pressing the right mouse button. Highlight a menu item and click the left mouse button to activate that particular function, or click either mouse button outside the menu to hide it.



Loading a Script

Creating a New Script

When you first start the program, a blank script will appear automatically. To create a new script:

1. Click 'New Script' on the context menu.

Opening a Script from Disk

To open a script from the hard drive or another location, do the following:

1. On the context menu, click 'Open Script'.
2. In the Open dialog box, find the file to open.
3. Highlight the file, then click 'Open'.

Importing Text from a Different Program

An easy method of importing text from another program is with the 'Cut' and 'Paste' commands:

1. Open the script in its original program.
2. Select all the text, then press 'Ctrl-C'.
3. Create a new script in TeleScript JR, then press 'Ctrl-V'.

Editing the Script

Changing Fonts

The Font dialog allows you to set the font for the currently selected text. To open the Font dialog:

1. Select the text you want to change.
2. On the context menu, click 'Font...'
3. Select a new font and size, then click 'OK'.

Formatting Attributes and Alignment

You can apply text formatting such as Bold, Italic, Underline, etc. to a selection, or align the entire line:

1. Select the text you want to format.
2. Select formatting from the 'Attributes' menu.

Changing Text and Background Colors

You can specify black on white or white on black text colors:

1. Click on 'Text Color' on the context menu.
2. Select the desired color from the sub-menu.

Prompter

Starting scrolling

Unlike other prompting programs, TeleScript JR doesn't have separate editing and prompting modes. To start scrolling, select 'Start Scrolling' from the context menu, or click the middle mouse button (or wheel on some mice.)

Mouse Control

In TeleScript JR, the prompter can be controlled by the mouse cursor motion. Here's how to use it:

- Click the middle button to start scrolling.
- Move the mouse down to scroll forward.
- Move the mouse up to scroll back.
- Click any mouse button to stop.

Scroll Sensitivity

The amount of mouse movement required to alter the speed of scrolling is set using the 'Scroll Sensitivity' settings. 'Low' requires the most motion to affect speed; 'High' requires less movement.

Getting Help

TeleScript JR has a complete help and documentation system built in. To access it, select 'Help' from the context menu, or press the <F1> key.

Demo Limitations

When using TeleScript JR in demo mode, the functionality is limited compared to the unlocked mode.

With the demo, the length of text that may be opened or imported is limited, and the prompter mode will render the text unreadable.
